Morning



Day 3 - Siena

Morning

Drive to Siena and visit of the town with an English-speaking guide. Siena is renowned worldwide for its art, museums, medieval cityscape, gastronomy and the Palio, a historic horserace held twice a year. Lunch in the typical restaurant *Antica Osteria da Divo*.


Afternoon

Afternoon


Visit of the Pagani Supercar Factory and Museum. This small company is known to be a rising star among Italian Supercar manufacturers. These "hyper-cars" are considered to be "artworks" because of the superior materials used for their construction, such as carbon fiber. After the visit, guests will drive to Merano. Check-in at the Hotel Castel located near the historical centre of Merano.

The dinner will be served at the restaurant of the Hotel.

Total driving: Approx. 6 hours 10 min. - 545 Km - 339 Miles
















Day 5 -Cortina d'Ampezzo

Morning

Day trip from Merano to Cortina d'Ampezzo driving through the beautiful Dolomites which are part of the UNESCO's World Heritage. Arrival in Cortina d'Ampezzo, also called the "Queen of the Dolomites" for the extreme glamour and the refined services offered as well as for the exceptional beauty of its mountainous landscape and lunch at the beautiful Hotel Cristallo.

Afternoon


Drive back to Merano passing through Dobbiaco and Brunico. Afternoon at leisure.

Day 6 - Passo dello Stelvio

Morning

This day will certainly be remembered for the drive to the thrilling Passo dello Stelvio*.

Located in the Ortler Alps, the "Stelvio Pass" (one of Europe's highest mountain roads) is a mountain pass reaching an height of 2.757 meters a.s.l.. (9,045 feet). Once on the top of the Passo dello Stelvio, guests will be rewarded with breathtaking views of the majestic glaciers and of the high peaks reaching 4.000 meters a.s.l. (13.123 feet).

The road itself is a marvel of engineering skills. It could be considered the most magnificent road pass in Europe and it's definitely one of the most scenic drives in the world. The Passo dello Stelvio is considered to be really challenging for drivers because of the presence of 48 hairpin bends.


Arrival at L'Albereta Hotel in Franciacorta (near Brescia).

The "Autodromo di Franciacorta" race track will be of exclusive use of our guests who will drive the selected hyper-cars, seated next to professional pilots who will assist them with all their best advices.


Afternoon

Main Features & recap of included Services

- Eight-day road rally tour on the most exciting roads of Lazio, Tuscany, Emilia Romagna, Veneto, Trentino Alto Adige and Lombardy.

- Seven-night accommodation in a double-bedroom with breakfast in 5-star luxury hotels: one night at the Grand Hotel Via Veneto in Rome, two nights at the Hotel Fonteverde in San Casciano dei Bagni, two nights at the Park Hotel Mignon & Spa in Merano and two nights at L'Albereta Relais & Chateaux in Erbusco.

- Five-day access and use of the chosen supercar with kasko car insurance for all cars (up to 1600 km - 1000 miles driving - Extra km will cost 5€ Vat included). Speeding is at the driver's risk and possible tickets are covered by the driver. In case of damages, driver is responsible from 10.000€ to 20.000€. Exceeding that amount the insurance will cover the rest.

- Tour Director and Staff (with their own cars) in proportional number to the participants.

- Intensive Ferrari and Lamborghini briefing and assistance during the whole trip.
- Highway toll, use of Telepass, fuel and all the services related to the vehicles such as parking, refueling and carwashing are included.
- Walkie-talkies (while driving: guests and staff are always connected through radio).
- Half-day at the "Autodromo di Franciacorta" race track with exclusive use of a Ferrari 458 Challenge and a Lamborghini Huracán Super Trofeo.
- Luggage transportation (max. four bags per super car).
- All transfers from/to the Airports and from/to the restaurants.
- Rome by night tour with luxury vintage cars.
- Visit with an English-speaking guide of the Pagani Factory in Modena

Prices and Conditions

Payment Policy

- 30% deposit is required when booking. It can be paid by bank transfer or with a credit card.
- 70% balance is required 60 days prior to arrival. It can be paid by bank transfer or with credit card.
- The deposit for the car will be requested one week before arrival.
- If reservation request is performed within 60 days prior to arrival date, 100% payment is required.

Cancellation Policy

- 60 days or more prior to arrival: 30% cancellation fee.
- 59 to 45 days prior to arrival: 40% cancellation fee.
- 44 to 30 days prior to arrival: 50% cancellation fee.
- 30 to 16 days prior to arrival: 75% cancellation fee.
- Within 15 days prior to arrival: 100% cancellation fee.
- No-Show or earlier departures: 100% cancellation fee.

Cancellation fee is calculated on the total amount of the reservation.

The program is indicative and may be modified at the discretion of the organization. The program can be adapted to clients' wishes and can be subject to surcharge.

Once the Tour is started, services that clients choose not to use will not be refunded.
